

Parent Chaperone Expectations

1. Parents are eligible to be chaperones if they have submitted a copy of a valid driver's license, insurance declaration and have a current background check that has been approved by the school.
2. While on a trip with students, the school does not allow: alcohol consumption, illegal substance use, weapons or driving while texting/ talking on a cell phone.
3. To ensure the safety of the chaperones and students, chaperones should not be alone with any individual student. Any individual interactions with students should take place in visible public spaces.
4. Any discipline or communication issues regarding students is to be shared with the student's teacher who will then communicate information to the necessary parties.
5. Children under the age of 13 must sit in the backseat unless specific, written consent has been provided to the school from the parent.
6. Chaperones are permitted to use phones for photographs and for instructional or medical purposes. When possible, chaperones should avoid reading, or sending personal text messages when with students unless they are able to step away.
7. All students are required to wear seatbelts.
8. While on trips, vehicles are technology - free zones for Sterling students.
9. Chaperones are not permitted to make additional side trips, or to provide additional snacks. This does not include restroom breaks.
