# TEACHING & LEARNING

### Montessori PK3 and PK4 and Kindergarten -

face-to-face instruction 5 days a week.

#### **Distance Learning Track**

 Continues as designed for the remainder of year.

Beginning March 1, 2021, Kindergarten students **currently in the Blended Learning model** will return to school each week, rather than being separated in Group 1 and Group 2. Children's House (CH) students on campus will no longer receive Zoom or Seesaw lessons due to the fact that they are now on campus consistently. These students are required to meet the instructional working hours and therefore will **not** be dismissing at 12:00pm on Fridays. Typical dismissal will be from 3:00-3:30pm.

Distance Learning Track, and the Blended Learning Track each have very different characteristics and require different types of support and methods to help children grow socially, emotionally and academically. Sterling Montessori is committed to meet the parent and student's needs under each of these models. In order to achieve this mission, Children's House has decided to dedicate Distance Learning Teachers to the Distance Learning students/families and dedicate Blended Learning teachers for those who choose that track.

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### **Every Week on Campus: Face-to-Face**

Each week on campus (face to face) will be full of lessons with the hands-on Montessori materials, socialization, and opportunities to repeat the lessons presented with hands-on materials. Opportunities to learn how to be independent and develop the necessary executive functioning skills to be successful in a group Montessori educational setting.

### What it looks like in the Classroom:

#### **SAMPLE SCHEDULE**

8:00- 8:25am	Prepare the environment  Morning drop-off for Before Care students will start at 8:00  Parents will drop-off in carpool lane. Sterling staff will greet parent and child at car and follow the following protocol: Temperature check and Health screening The student will be escorted to the classroom by a designated Sterling staff member Students will use hand-sanitizer before entering the room Students will put belongings away and wash hands for at least 20sec
8:25- 9:00am	Morning drop-off:
9:00- 11:15am	<ul> <li>Morning Work Cycle 9:00-11:15: Children select works from a variety of educational activities. Lessons are given in Math, Reading, Writing, Geography, Science, Sensorial and Practical Life         <ul> <li>Reinforcing social distancing throughout the work cycle as much as possible</li> <li>Incorporating frequent handwashing opportunities throughout the work cycle</li> <li>Monitoring children closely to determine if the material needs to be cleaned and sanitized based upon how the child works with the materials (did they sneeze/cough on materials, put hands in mouth and then touch material, etc.)</li> <li>Allow time between activities for proper cleaning and disinfection of high-touch surfaces</li></ul></li></ul>

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#### SAMPLE SCHEDULE (cont.)

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11:15- 11:40am	<ul> <li>Morning Circle Time begins-allow for plenty of space for children to practice social distancing</li> <li>Stories, Calendar, Songs, Grace and Courtesy Lessons, Cultural Lessons.</li> <li>Sing Morning welcome song</li> <li>Read Book pertaining to the weekly topic</li> <li>While teacher is at circle with students, the floater will clean and sanitize tables (soapy water first, then sanitizer using one paper towel per table;</li> <li>Clean/sanitize high touch areas (light switches, doorknobs, sinks, etc.)</li> <li>Clean/sanitize classroom bathrooms</li> <li>Spray down materials using Sanitizer spray leaving the solution on materials to dry.</li> <li>Set lunch boxes on chairs (take from the refrigerator)         <ul> <li>No placemats, cloth or otherwise, will be used at this time</li> <li>Encourage parents to put food in easy to open containers and all food will stay in containers</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
11:45- 12:30pm	Lunch time:  Students and teachers will Wash hands for at least 20 sec  Children will find their spot and begin lunch, children can sit at the same tables as they are in the same cohort  No microwaving of food at this time  Once lunch is complete students will put their lunch boxes away and clean tables with a water solution Teachers will clean tables with our cleaning solution
12:30- 1:10pm	Outside Playtime: Children are escorted to the outside playground by their teacher
1:15- 3:00pm	Afternoon work cycle: Return to the classroom through the patio door  • Students and teachers will use hand-sanitizer before entering the classroom  • Students will wash hands  • Children select works from a variety of educational activities. Lessons given in Math, Reading, Writing, Geography, Science, Sensorial and Practical Life
3:00- 3:30pm	Children clean-up and prepare for dismissal.  Works are carefully put away and children collect their belongings for dismissal  Dismissal will begin at 3:00 pm for those children whose parents are in the carpool lane.  Kindergarteners are escorted by staff to their parents who are in the carpool lane
3:30-	Prep-Time in Classroom  Tables, chairs, materials, sinks, high touch areas are all cleaned and sanitized following all cleaning procedures as outlined above

# **DISTANCE LEARNING TRACK**

### What it looks like

Schedule will remain the same.

- Whole class group meeting
- Small group live work cycle

Afternoon free to work on Seesaw assignments, attend individual lesson with teacher.
