## PFSA Community Meeting Tuesday, September 24, 2004

## Welcome and Introduction to all! Meeting began at 4:05pm

### Stephanie discussed the PFSA vision

- Sterling's PFSA is not a typical hierarchical structure with President, Vice President, et al, but rather committees and chairs that run the events

- PFSA falls under the Development umbrella and is about building community - Parents, Faculty, Students (Montessori based methodology) Association; Sterling Montessori is a non profit, charter school; no public funding from the county like WCPSS. Rather, funding is based on enrollment numbers at the beginning of each school year.

Therefore, efforts have to go into fundraising and development.

### **PFSA Yearly Budget:**

Running budget \$12-15K. This is used throughout the year to cover events PFSA puts on, such as Movie Nights, Garden Days, International Festival et al. Have to remember that these events cost money to provide community and that we want to be able to include as may people in our community with the events, but must look to ways to sustain the cost and manpower for these events to occur.

Need People Power - chairs are point people to run events. Time is just as valuable as money donated and we are appreciative of any type of donation.

Sterling's PFSA is essentially in the hands of the parents and community members. There are traditional events that we have enjoyed having throughout the years but Development is always open to new ideas and such, as long as there is support from the community to make the events happen.
