PREPARATION FOR RETURN TO SCHOOL




We will welcome a number of students back to campus on Tuesday, April 6th, after Spring Break. We ask that over the break, families review our latest Reopening Plans, which does detail our updated COVID protocols. All new placement information has gone out. If you have not received information and you have requested a change from distance to on-campus learning, please email your director.

CARPOOL - NEW CARPOOL PROCEDURE - In order to accommodate more students returning to campus, we have had to adjust our Carpool Procedures, particularly for UE and MS families currently following the YELLOW carpool route. Please review THIS DOCUMENT (link) that outlines the procedures for each level.

CARPOOL TAGS: Returning Families Please remember to clearly display your carpool tag when in the pick-up lane. **Bring your carpool tag with you daily!** Anyone who does not have a tag will need to park, answer a series of health questions and have their temperature taken. They will then need to visit the Main Office with their driver's license in order to confirm their identity and are permitted to pick up the student.

Families should continue to use their carpool tags from last year. **If you are new to Sterling** and have not yet received your carpool tags, please email schase@sterlingmontessori.org as soon as possible with the name and classroom of the oldest child who will be on campus. If you would like to rent additional tags, you may do so through Sterling's Website via My School Bucks.

DEVICE RETURN - all returning students who borrowed Chromebook devices, and will start on-campus full-time **must return them to school on Tuesday, April 6th**. They can be sent in with the student and turned in to the student's teacher. Please be sure to include the power supply. Thank you!

2021-22 SCHOOL YEAR UPDATE

Sterling has been notified by the Office of Charter Schools (OCS) that all charters will follow the law as it existed pre-COVID for calendar requirements. Therefore, we will follow our <u>calendar</u> accordingly. There is also no current authorization in statute for charters to conduct remote learning for the 2021-2022 school year. Of course, the General Assembly may enact a new law to apply to the 2021-22 school year that addresses whether remote learning can be offered. All charters can proceed at this time with setting up the school year according to requirements applied prior to COVID. This means we are not authorized to include remote instruction for the 2021-22 school year at this time.

We are excited about Fall 2021 and are actively planning now for a full return to on-campus learning complying with all health and safety guidelines and will not be offering a Distance Learning track. We will work with students who have a medical plan. Any questions related to medical accommodations can be directed to <u>Carrie Smith</u> or <u>Rownak Ifat</u>.








COVID EDUCATION
