COVID EDUCATION

MODIFICATIONS TO MASK REQUIREMENTS. As outdoor temperatures warm, we've been asked about any changes to our mask requirements. According to NCDHHS (which we follow), masks are not required when students are outside for recess AND maintaining 6 feet of physical distancing at all times; a teacher holds class outdoors with ALL individuals consistently maintaining 6 feet of physical distancing at all times; students are participating in an outdoor P.E. class with all individuals consistently maintaining 6 feet of physical distanding at all times.

Amanda Keighley - Children's House Lead Teacher

"My name is Amanda Keighley, and I have been a Montessori teacher for seventeen years and the A4 teacher at Sterling for seven years. I was lucky enough to attend a Montessori school for six years as a child and have wonderful memories of how I felt in that beautiful and serene environment. I try to provide the same experience to the children in my classroom. One of the most rewarding parts of my job is watching children become readers.

Literacy is so powerful, and the child's world unlocks when they can read. Sharing and reading wonderful children's literature is a joy. I like to share classics, favorites from my childhood, One Morning in Maine by Robert McCloskey for one, and thoughtful recently published books like Lovely by Jess Hong. I encourage parents and children to seek out their local children's librarian, who has the keys to the castle as it were. RAMADAN

This week began the holy month of Ramadan for Muslim families.
